With track activities over the 3 days, we will ensure “Engines Off” from 21h00 to 07h00 on Thursday and Friday whereas the actual Kyalami 9 Hour Race will finish at 22h00 on Saturday, 5th February 2022. As with the other International Events at the Kyalami Grand Prix Circuit we expect some helicopter landings by guests and drone operations by our Media Partners, all of this will be approved by the CAA.

The limited attendance as per Lockdown Regulation Level 1 of 2 000 Fully Vaccinated Spectators on Saturday the 5th February 2022 will have very little impact on the traffic patterns on Main Road and Allandale Road, JMPD has been contracted to do duty at the main entrance on said date.

As always we will ensure City of Johannesburg JOC Compliance and as a Medium Risk Event we will have a fully operational VOC on site manned by the SAPS, JMPs , COJ Fire Safety, COJ Disaster Management and COJ Environmental Health.
