Hi Glenferness

Just a quick note after the meeting with Dylan Weakley from the City for those who may support change in Glenferness:

1. The UDB can be changed by resolution of council, and has previously been changed.
2. He, Dylan, is personally not supportive of changing the UDB. (Many of his reasons are valid, but our reasons to be included in the UDB are equally valid).
3. Precinct Plans can be adopted and when agreed become a part of the SDF and are fully enforceable by the City. (Any fears of unwanted development can thus be allayed and enforced)
4. We need permission from the City to develop a Precinct Plan. (It has always been our intention to partner with the City in developing a Precinct Plan.)
5. We were told that we are unlikely to get permission to do a Precinct Plan whilst outside the UDB. (We weren't told we would get permission, just that it's unlikely)
6. So the priority remains to get a seat at the table to change the UDB.
7. Then we can explore options for Glenferness and make it a place that works for everyone!
